Serves as an assessor for the 242 Church Planting Network and a national trainer for the National African American Fellowship and myBlvd Church Planting Cohorts

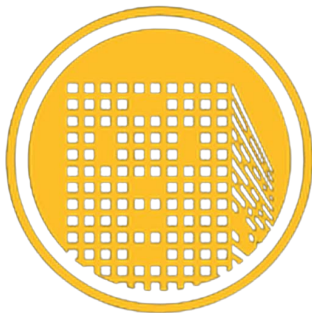
MAJOR MILESTONES

Brian Crawford served for 14 years as a federal civilian for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Vicksburg District. During his time, Brian served as the Leadership Development Program Director and was also appointed as both the youngest Strategic Planner (2010) and the youngest Chief of Information Technology (2012) in the District's history.

Brian joined the U.S. Army Engineer Research and Development Center in 2015. During the past six years, he has served as the manager for the High Performance Computing Modernization Program (HPCMP) Cybersecurity Team and as a supervisor for the Defensive Cyber Operations team. In 2021 Brian was selected to become the chief of Cybersecurity Engineering and Analysis, a team of over 160 cybersecurity professionals.
